ORDINANCE NO. 11692

AN ORDINANCE extending sewer system Franchise No. 600 for the City of Enumclaw until December 31, 1995, and authorizing the issuance of right-of-way construction permits.

- 1. The City of Enumclaw Franchise No. 600, to operate and maintain a sewer system on county road right of way, has expired.
- 2. On November 17, 1994 the King County health department, environmental health division notified Warren Lokovsek, the owner of property located at 44903 284 Avenue Southeast, that his septic system was discharging into the surface of the ground and represented a public health risk.
- 3. Since Mr. Lokovsek operates a day care center from his residence, the health department is concerned about the public health risk associated with the operation of the center with a failing septic system.
- 4. The health department strongly encourages that this residence be connected to the City of Enumclaw's sanitary sewer main running along 284th Avenue Southeast to eliminate the potential public health risks to the day care center and neighboring properties.
- 5. Warren Lokovsek has asked to connect to the City of Enumclaw's six-inch sewer main at the intersection of Southeast 449th Street and 284th Avenue Southeast.
- 6. While the City of Enumclaw does not encourage or support sewer service outside its corporate boundary due to the capacity limit of their sewer treatment plant, and the cost associated with the development of a new system, under City of Enumclaw Ordinance No. 1794, the City will allow new sewer service connections for septic tank failures that have occurred immediately outside the city limits that may cause health hazards to residences within the city limits.
- 7. The City of Enumclaw has agreed to provide sanitary sewer to this residence, but with the expiration of Sewer Franchise No. 600, they will be unable to obtain the necessary right of way construction permit to perform the service line connection in unincorporated King County.
- 8. The City of Enumclaw anticipates that it will submit its Sewer Comprehensive Plan for county approval in 1995.

- 9. The King County utilities technical review committee recommends that the franchise be extended for one year for this purpose, and to allow the City of Enumclaw the time needed to submit and obtain approval of their sewer comprehensive plan from King County.
- 10. Though the metropolitan King County council has adopted Ordinance 11664, whose substantive provisions are identical to this ordinance, the council did so without following the notice procedures identified in R.C.W. 36.55.040. It did so after determining that the emergency urgent public health nature of the action took precedence over the technical notice requirements and that enactment of this ordinance after due notice would remedy any procedural deficiencies.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. 13.24 to the contrary, the King County executive is hereby authorized to grant an extension of Sewer Franchise No. 600 for the City of Enumclaw until December 31, 1995, in substantially the same form as Attachment "A." Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. 14.44 to the contrary, the executive is also authorized to issue right-of-way construction permits necessary to address public health risks consistent with the terms of this extended franchise. Actions taken by the executive prior to the effective date of this ordinance but consistent with provisions of Ordinance 11664 are hereby ratified and confirmed.
