AN ORDINANCE establishing the 1995 subject matter and work program for the Regional Policy Committee of the Metropolitan King County Council.

## PREAMBLE:

The amendments to the King County Charter approved by the voters in 1992 created three regional committees. These committees include the Regional Transit Committee, Regional Water Quality Committee and the Regional Policy Committee. The Regional Water Quality Committee and Regional Transit Committee subject matter areas consist of those previously assigned to the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle. The Regional Policy Committee subject matter is not specified although several possible subject matters are included in the charter.

The Regional Policy Committee met at a retreat on January 14, 1995 to discuss and decide on the issues the committee would consider during 1995 and 1996. This ordinance reflects the agreements that resulted from the January 14th retreat of the Regional Policy Committee.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The work program for the Regional Policy
Committee for 1995 shall primarily focus on public health and
the design of the process specified in Substitute Senate Bill
5038, Chapter 266 Laws of Washington 1994. In addition the
work program will include issues the committee has considered
to date, including but not limited to consolidation
transition and solid waste policies. The committee will
develop a regional policy framework for each issue the
committee considers.

SECTION 2. In developing additional items for its work program, the committee will be guided by the following considerations:

ll.
