ORDINANCE NO. **11695**

2 AN ORDINANCE establishing the 1995
3 subject matter and work program for the
4 Regional Policy Committee of the
5 Metropolitan King County Council.

6 PREAMBLE:

7 The amendments to the King County Charter approved
8 by the voters in 1992 created three regional
9 committees. These committees include the Regional
10 Transit Committee, Regional Water Quality Committee
11 and the Regional Policy Committee. The Regional
12 Water Quality Committee and Regional Transit
13 Committee subject matter areas consist of those
14 previously assigned to the Municipality of
15 Metropolitan Seattle. The Regional Policy
16 Committee subject matter is not specified although
17 several possible subject matters are included in
18 the charter.

19 The Regional Policy Committee met at a retreat on
20 January 14, 1995 to discuss and decide on the
21 issues the committee would consider during 1995 and
22 1996. This ordinance reflects the agreements that
23 resulted from the January 14th retreat of the
24 Regional Policy Committee.

25 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

26 SECTION 1. The work program for the Regional Policy
27 Committee for 1995 shall primarily focus on public health and
28 the design of the process specified in Substitute Senate Bill
29 5038, Chapter 266 Laws of Washington 1994. In addition the
30 work program will include issues the committee has considered
31 to date, including but not limited to consolidation
32 transition and solid waste policies. The committee will
33 develop a regional policy framework for each issue the
34 committee considers.

35 SECTION 2. In developing additional items for its work
36 program, the committee will be guided by the following
37 considerations:

1 The committee will determine additional subject matter
2 areas for its work program;

3 The subject matter can and will change over time;

4 The committee will focus on a limited number of issues
5 at one time; and

6 The committee will provide a forum for discussion of
7 emerging regional issues.

8 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 6th
9 day of February, 1995.

10 PASSED by a vote of 11 to 0 this 21st day of
11 February, 1995.
