ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation to various agencies for the purpose of enhancing courthouse security, and amending Ordinance 11578, Sections 16, 30, 38, and 102, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

STATEMENT OF INTENT:

- 1. Due to the current and emergent situation, the provision of security to the courts located within the King County Courthouse requires that the executive, in conjunction with the superior court, temporarily screen all entrances to the Courthouse for weapons until a permanent policy, which addresses the legal issues of weapons screening, is adopted by council.
- 2. The executive will continue to gather data and perform an analysis of the permanent security needs of the Courthouse, district court, and other essential county facilities, with the goal of providing the safest, most cost effective security program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation to various agencies for the purpose of enhancing courthouse security.
