ORDINANCE NO.111712

AN ORDINANCE approving the merger of Cascade View Water District into Sammamish Plateau Water & Sewer District for the purpose of creating one consolidated special purpose district to provide water service.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- A notice of intention proposing the merger of the Cascade View Water District into Sammamish Plateau Water & Sewer District for consolidating water services was filed with the county council effective February 13, 1995.
- Sammamish Plateau Water & Sewer District, by Resolution No. 1748, and Cascade View Water District, by Resolution No. 9-94, have each agreed that the merger would be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience of, and be of special benefit to, the lands within both Districts, have signed a merger agreement, and have agreed that the Sammamish Plateau Water & Sewer District would be the designated SEPA Lead Agency.
- The Sammamish Plateau Water & Sewer District filed a Determination of Nonsignificance dated January 18,1995 on the proposed merger.
- The county council held a public hearing on the 13th nach, 19 95 and has considered the day of _ criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.040.
- The merger of the Cascade View Water SECTION 1. District, described in Attachment A, into the Sammamish Plateau Water & Sewer District, is approved. This proposed merger is consistent with R.C.W. 56.02.040.
- Sammamish Plateau Water & Sewer District is SECTION 2. the appropriate entity to provide water service to the area proposed to be merged.

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That real property located in King County, State of Washington and legally described as follows:

All of Section 14, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M.

Together with the southeast one-quarter of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M.

Together with all those portions of Section 11, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M., described as follows:

The south one-half;

AND

The east one-half of the northeast one-quarter;

AND

The west one-half of the northwest one-quarter of the northwest one-quarter;

AND

The west one-half and the west 30 feet of the east one-half of the southwest one-quarter of the northwest one-quarter; AND

The south 495 feet of the east one-half of the southwest one-quarter of the northwest one-quarter less the west 30 feet.

Together with all those portions of Section 13, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M., described as follows:

The southwest one-quarter;

AND

All that portion of the northwest one-quarter lying southerly of the northerly margin of the Union Hill Road;

All that portion of the northeast one-quarter lying southwesterly of the centerline of the Union Hill Road;

All that portion of the southeast one-quarter lying southwesterly of the centerline of the Union Hill Road and northwesterly of the southeasterly plat line of the plat of Cascade View Tracts as recorded in the records of King County, Volume 68 of Plats, pages 93, 94, 95, 96, and 97.

Together with all that portion of the northwest one-quarter of the southwest one-quarter of Section 18, Township 25 North, Range 7 East, W.M., lying southwesterly of the centerline of Union Hill Road and northwesterly of the southeasterly plat line of the plat of Cascade View Tracts as recorded in the records of King County, Volume 68 of Plats, pages 93, 94, 95, 96, and 97.
