- The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has secured the neccessary easements in the vacation area.
- The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principals and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open for public use. A search of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- The right-of-way is classified as C Class road and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$5,826.50 from the petitioner.
