7 SECTION 1. Ordinance 1008, Section 1 and K.C.C.

8 12.44.550 is hereby amended to read as follows:

9 **Boating advisory commission.** A. There is hereby
10 established a boating advisory commission composed of such
11 members as may be selected by the county executive and
12 approved by the county council.

13 B. The boating advisory commission shall recommend to
14 the county council ways and means for improving boating
15 conditions. The commission shall meet upon the call of the
16 chairman.
