ORDINANCE NO. **11744**

AN ORDINANCE approving the City of Duvall
Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

On August 24, 1994 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The City of Duvall Comprehensive Water System Plan was approved by vote of the city council on April 28, 1994.

The City of Duvall issued a determination of nonsignificance for the Plan in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act on October 21, 1993.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The City of Duvall Comprehensive Water System Plan, attached as Exhibit A, is hereby approved without conditions.
