ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE approving the Northshore Utility District Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

On January 26, 1994 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The Northshore Utility District Comprehensive Water System Plan was approved by vote of the Northshore Utility District Commissioners on October 30, 1993.

The Northshore Utility District issued a determination of nonsignificance for the Plan in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act on December 30, 1993.
