AN ORDINANCE renaming Fund 112 Involuntary Treatment to Fund 112 Mental Health, moving that fund from a Second Tier Fund to a First Tier Fund, and amending King County Code 4.10.020 and 4.10.030.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Section 4.10.030 of King County Code is hereby amended to read as follows: Second tier funds. A. Second tier funds are as follows, except to the extent that all or a portion of any listed fund is a first tier fund by virtue of any other provision of this chapter:

Provided further, that in calendar year 1985 the amount of interest accruing to the Current Expense Fund which is attributable to residual treasury cash in the County Roads Fund shall not exceed the difference between the 1984 and the 1985 total real and personal unincorporated area property tax levy diverted to the Current Expense Fund plus the forest excise and harvest tax amounts diverted from the County Roads Fund to the Current Expense Fund shall not exceed the reduction to the diversion between the years 1984 and 1985 and there is hereby appropriated from the Current Expense Fund to the County Roads Fund any such excess amount as calculated by the director of finance.
