- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of 88th Avenue Northeast hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that all necessary easements have been acquired.
- 3. The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The right-of-way is classified C-Class. King County Code 14.40.020(C) authorizes waiver of the portion of the compensation due King County from Northshore School District #417 for the vacation of the subject right-of-way. The waiver is justified by the services and benefits which are provided to King County and its citizens by the Northshore School District.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 7th day of June, 1995.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
