ORDINANCE NO. **11889**

AN ORDINANCE approving the Ames Lake Water Association 1992 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

On January 12, 1994 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The Ames Lake Water Association 1992 Comprehensive Water System Plan was approved by vote of the association commissioners on December 8, 1992.

The Ames Lake Water Association is categorically exempt from State Environmental Policy Act rules in accordance with WAC 197-11-800(24)(b) and 197-11-305(a), since none of its lines are greater than eight inches in diameter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Ames Lake Water Association 1992 Comprehensive Water System Plan, Attachment A, is hereby approved without conditions.
