ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation to various agencies from unappropriated fund balance for the purpose of enhancing building security through the end of 1995, amending Ordinance 11578, Sections 16, 102, 117 and Attachment 1, as amended;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation to the various agencies from the unappropriated fund balances, for the purpose of enhancing building security through the end of 1995.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 11578, Section 16, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Department of Public Safety 1,207,940

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 11578, Section 102, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

DCFM - INTERNAL SERVICE FUND - From the Internal Service Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

DCFM - Internal Service Fund \$103,188

SECTION 4. Ordinance Number 11578, Section 117 and Attachment 1, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

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PROVIDED THAT:

No funds shall be expended on the duress alarm system until the Law, Justice and Human Services Committee has reviewed the consultant's recommendation for this system.

PROVIDED FURTHER THAT:

The amount included in this appropriation is based upon the executive's proposed courthouse security plan which is currently undergoing council review in proposed Motion 95-355. In the event that the plan ultimately approved by the council results in an alteration of the courthouse security plan, the executive shall transmit to the council a proposed ordinance altering this appropriation consistent with the final plan.
