AN ORDINANCE relating to the change of name of King County Water District No. 107 to Coal Creek Utility District.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings. The King County Council hereby makes the follwing findings:

- The Board of Commissioners of Water District No.107, King County, Washington State, has determined that it would be in the best interest of the district to change its name to "Coal Creek Utility District" since the district's current name does not provide customers any geographical type of identification, and making it more locally recognizable.
- The district filed Resolution No. 1453 with the King County Council, resolving to change the name of the district from King County Water District No. 107 to "Coal Creek Utility District".

- 2. The District manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit a certified copy of this resolution to the Clerk of the King County Council and to pursue the expeditious review and approval of such resolution and name change by the King County Council.
