ORDINANCE NO. 11951

AN ORDINANCE approving the King County Water District No. 111 Amendment to the Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans for water purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits.

On January 11, 1995 the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24 recommended approval.

The King County Water District No. 111 Amendment to the Comprehensive Water System Plan was approved by vote of the district commissioners on April 28, 1994.

King County Water District No. 111 issued a determination of nonsignificance for the plan in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act on April 28, 1994.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Water District No. 111 Amendment to the Comprehensive Water System Plan, Attachment A, is hereby approved without conditions.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 31st day of July, 1995.
