ORDINANCE NO. **11960**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing expansion of the project scope of the City of Kent Interurban Trail 1989 Open Space Bond Project to include paving and necessary improvements of the Interurban Trail from James Street north to the city limits with the City of Tukwila.

PREAMBLE:

1. The city of Kent (City) has accomplished the original scope of the 1989 Open Space Bond Project to pave selected portions of the Interurban Regional Trail and funds of \$209,487 remain..

2. The City has requested an expansion of the project scope to use remaining funds to rehabilitate and pave the interurban trail north of James Street, which was paved over 20 years ago and requires such rehabilitation and repaving for public safety and enjoyment.

3. The King County Open Space Citizens Oversight Committee recommends that the scope of the city of Kent Interurban Trail 1989 Open Space Bond Project should be expanded to include the rehabilitation and paving of the trail north of James Street in Kent, to be funded with remaining project funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an expansion of the scope of the city of Kent Interurban Trail 1989 Open Space Bond Project to include paving and necessary improvements of the trail north of James Street to the city limits with the city of Tukwila.

INTRODUCED AND READ for this first time this 31st day of July, 1995.

PASSED by a vote of 12 to 0 this 18th day of September 1995.

7 A RESOLUTION recommending the expansion of the project scope of the City  
8 of Kent Interurban Trail 1989 Open Space Bond Project

11 WHEREAS, by Section 11 of King County Ordinance 9071, the King County Council directed the  
12 establishment of the King County Open Space Citizens Oversight Committee (Committee); and

13  
14 WHEREAS, on April 14, 1990, the King County Council passed Motion 7886, which established the  
15 Committee to consider and address the concerns, needs and progress of all jurisdictions responsible for  
16 implementing Ordinance 9071 and to make recommendation on other requests transmitted to the Committee by the  
Executive or Council on important matters relating to open space in King County; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, Ordinance 9071 authorized the City of Kent 1989 Open Space Bond Project; and

19  
20 WHEREAS, the original goals of the City of Kent Interurban Trail 1989 Open Space Bond Project have been  
21 accomplished and funds in the amount of \$209,487 remain in the project budget; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, after more than 20 years of normal use, the Interurban Trail in Kent located north of James  
24 Street is in need of significant rehabilitation to bring the trail up to safety and comfort standards comparable to the  
25 portion of the trail paved under the 1989 Open Space Bond project scope and the adjoining recently completed portion  
26 of the trail in the City of Tukwila, and

28 WHEREAS, the Committee has reviewed the City's other 1989 Open Space Bond suburban city projects and  
29 has determined that the unanticipated funds from the Interurban Trail Project will likely not be needed for shortfalls in  
30 those projects.

32 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the King County Open Space Citizens Oversight Committee:

35 A. The Committee finds that the goals of the original Interurban Trail project scope have been met and  
36 that funds in the amount of \$209,487 remain in the project budget.

38 B. The Committee recommends that the project scope of the City of Kent Interurban Trail 1989 Open Space  
39 Bond Project should be expanded to include the rehabilitation and paving of the trail north of James  
40 Street in Kent, to be funded with remaining project funds.
