ORDINANCE NO. **11968**

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$12,781,900 to procure equipment as part of the Trauma Center and Ambulatory Care Center project plans and amending Ordinance 11578, Section 117, Attachment 1B, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$12,781,900 from unappropriated Harborview Medical Center Funds to procure equipment for the new Trauma Center and Ambulatory Care Center.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 11578, Section 117, Attachment 1B, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 2.42 of the King County Code, the King County Harborview Project Office is authorized to use, in addition to the King County Purchasing Department and the procedures set forth in Chapter 4.16 of the King County Code, the following agencies, contracts, and procurement methods for the purchase of equipment related to the Harborview Medical Center Long Range Capital Improvement Project:

1. Harborview Medical Center Purchasing Department and its contracts and procurement methods;

2. University of Washington Purchasing Department and its contracts and procurement methods;

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3. The Federal General Services Administration and its contracts and procurement methods;

4. University Hospital Consortium contracts.
