2 AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of
3 \$30,000 to the Boundary Review Board from Special
4 Programs - Executive Contingency for a feasibility study of the
5 proposed incorporation of Covington; and amending
6 Ordinance 11578, Sections 35 and 38, as amended.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation
9 of \$30,000 to the boundary review board from special programs - executive contingency,
10 for a feasibility study of the proposed incorporation of Covington.

11 Provided that: 1) the feasibility study methodology and data should be based on
12 recent and historic experience, and work scope should be consistent with previous studies;
13 2) the Citizen's for Covington Incorporation should appoint one representative to be
14 afforded the opportunity to comment on and make input into the selection of the consultant
15 and concerning the work scope; 3) the contract for this study should be awarded to a
16 separate consultant from the consultant selected for the Maple Valley incorporation study
17 (Prop. Ordinance No. 95-783), unless the incorporation representatives agree to utilize one
18 consultant; 4) the schedule should be targeted to allow for a September 1996
19 incorporation election.

20 SECTION 2. Ordinance 11578, Section 35, as amended, is hereby amended by
21 adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

22 BOUNDARY REVIEW BOARD - From the Current Expense Fund, there is
