ORDINANCE NO. **12080**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing expansion of the project scope of the King County Three Forks Park 1989 Open Space Bond Project to include five parcels totaling 23 acres along Reinig Road.

PREAMBLE:

1. The Three Forks Park 1989 Open Space Bond Project is authorized under Ordinance 9071 and includes acquisition of lands at the confluence of the three main branches of the Snoqualmie River near the Cities of North Bend and Snoqualmie, including connections to the Snoqualmie Valley Regional Trail and the Mount Si Conservation Area.
2. King County has identified five parcels of land along Reinig Road necessary for trail access through the park between the Snoqualmie Valley Trail and the Mount Si Conservation Area and to connect the county's holdings on either side of these parcels.
3. The King County Open Space Citizens Oversight Committee recommends that the 1989 Open Space Bond Three Forks Park project be expanded to include the five parcel, 23 acre addition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved the expansion of the project scope of the King County Three Forks Park 1989 Open Space Bond Project to include five parcels totaling 23 acres along Reinig Road.

INTRODUCED AND READ for this first time this 16th day of October 1995.
