AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of a portion of 148th Avenue Southeast - V-2081
Petitioner: King County Department of Public Works for King County Department of Parks, Planning and Resources, Parks Division

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. The department of public works received a request from the department of parks, planning and resources, parks division requesting vacation of a portion of 148th Avenue Southeast hereinafter described.
- 2. The portion of 148th Avenue Southeast to be vacated has been replaced by a realignment and construction of 152nd Way Southeast.
- 3. The proposed vacation area is within the boundaries of the Lake Meridian county park and was incorporated into the development of the park. When finalized, the vacation will transfer the former right-of-way to the parks division.
- 4. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements are required by Puget Sound Power and Light Company, Soos Creek Water and Sewer District, King County Water District No. 111 and U.S. West Communications.
- 5. The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 6. An easement to provide access to private property is required by owners of private property adjacent to the park so that they can have legal access to their property once the vacation becomes effective.
- 7. The department of public works has maintained 148th Avenue Southeast, also known as Phillips Raymond Road, in excess of twenty five years. A search of the records could not locate any deeds granting this right-of-way to King County. The County has an easement interest in this right-of-way rather than actual ownership in fee.
- 8. The department of public works considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the vacation of this road right-of-way and the transfer of the property to the department of parks, natural and cultural resources.
- 9. The right-of-way is classified "B Class" and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County department of public works is based on seventy five percent of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. The compensation due is \$47,913.75.

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- The property services division determined that the 10. value of the right-of-way acquired from the department of parks, planning and resources, parks division for the construction of 152nd Avenue Southeast as being \$27,216.00. The parks division provided \$40,000.00 for the design of the 152nd Avenue Southeast project.
- 11. The department of public works recommends the vacation compensation fee be waived as the combined value of right-of-way acquisition and project participation exceed the value of the vacation area.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 27th day of September 1995.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition at such time as the easements noted in paragraph 4, above, are granted and legal access is provided to private property which currently has its sole access by way of the portion of 148th Avenue Southeast to be vacated.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The council hereby vacates and abandons the following described portion of 148th Avenue Southeast:

That portion of the Southwest quarter of Section 26 and the Southeast quarter of Section 27, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington described as follows:

That segment of 148th Avenue Southeast lying southerly of a line located 30 feet southerly of and parallel with the centerline of the 148th Avenue Southeast/152nd Avenue Southeast realignment as defined in survey 26-22-5-13 (project 500989) records of the Department of Public Works of said county and lying northerly of the North margin of Southeast Kent-Kangley Road (Southeast 272nd Street).

Contains an area of 55,000 square feet or 1.263 acres, M/L.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective upon completion of the following pre-effective conditions:

King County shall execute and deliver easements to Puget Sound Power and Light Company, U.S. West Communications, King County Water District No. 111, and Soos Creek Water and Sewer District which allow for maintenance of lines and facilities of the said utilities within the area of the right-of-way proposed to be vacated or within an alternative area acceptable to the affected grantee.

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King County shall execute and deliver to the owner(s) of Tax Lots 0022 and 0023 a conveyance of legal access to serve those lots.

The final date to meet the foregoing pre-effective conditions is December 31, 1995 (which date shall not be extended to the next business day).
