The adopted proviso restricting expenditures in Project #395524 until ongoing remodel projects on the 10th and 12th floors of the Courthouse are completed is rescinded. PROVIDED FURTHER:

The stadium manager shall submit a spending plan for funds to be expended in support of the Kingdome/Seahawk Task Force project to the Budget and Fiscal Management Committee on or before February 15, 1996. Upon completion of the Kingdome/Seahawk Task Force project, the stadium manager shall provide an itemization of expenses to the Budget and Fiscal Management Committee.

## PROVIDED FURTHER:

That from prior capital improvement appropriations, the Water Quality Program shall prepare a preliminary engineering estimate, work plan and technical report on the feasibility of constructing a power plant at the Renton site to be completed on or before December 31, 1997. The Director of the Department of Natural Resources shall immediately attempt to negotiate lower electric rates for the East Division treatment facility with electrical power providers, and will report progress of these negotiations to the Budget and Fiscal Management Committee by June 15, 1996.
