A search of the records indicates public funds have been expended for its improvement and maintenance. The department of public works believes the public would benefit by the return of this area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The right-of-way is classified B-Class and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on seventy-five percent of the appraised value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of \$262.61 from the petitioner.
