ORDINANCE NO. **12147**

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AN ORDINANCE making technical corrections to Ordinance 12029 to identify Special Programs within various departments, appropriating \$150,000 for possible repairs and replacement to the Issaquah Pool, restricting the expenditure of funds for changes to existing voter registration and elections systems, and amending Ordinance 12029, Section 13, 15, 17, 20, 43 and 110, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There are hereby approved and adopted technical corrections to Ordinance 12029 to identify certain special programs with no additional appropriation authority being granted to the supervising department/agency and a supplemental appropriation of \$150,000 to the Parks Division from the unexpended Current Expense Fund balance to reimburse the City of Issaquah up to \$150,000 for costs associated with capital facility repairs and replacement to the Issaquah Swimming Pool.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 12029, Section 13, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

BUDGET AND STRATEGIC PLANNING - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

\$100,000 of appropriated funds shall be used for contracting with:

SECTION 3. Ordinance 12029, Section 15, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PUBLIC SAFETY - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

\$51,000 of appropriated funds shall be used for contracting with:

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SECTION 4. Ordinance 12029, Section 17, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PARKS DIVISION - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:
Parks Division \$150,000

PROVIDED THAT:

Pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement Between King County and the City of Issaquah, up to \$150,000 is set aside in the Parks Division total 1996 adopted operating budget to reimburse the City of Issaquah for costs associated with capital facility repairs and replacement to the Issaquah Swimming Pool.

SECTION 5. Ordinance 12029, Section 20, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

EXECUTIVE ADMINISTRATION - From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:
Executive Administration \$0

PROVIDED THAT

\$25,000 of the appropriated funds shall be used to contract with:
Seattle Chamber of Commerce, Minority Tourism

SECTION 6. Ordinance 12029, Section 43, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
