AN ORDINANCE granting an extension of preliminary approval for the PLAT of CARRINGTON BLUFF, DIVISION II (BALD File No. S90P0055).

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- Carrington Bluff, Division II, is a part of the plat of Carrington Bluff. Division I of this plat received final approval and was recorded on November 8, 1994.
- 2. The property owner, after regaining control of the property from the previous developer, has consulted with a local engineering firm who have indicated that the plat can be finished within the time that would be allowed by an extension of the plat.
- 3. It is important to have Division II completed as planned because a variance granted for storm drainage in Division I was based on more permanent solutions to be built in Division II of the plat.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings. The council finds that:

- A. The applicant has filed a written request for an extension for preliminary plat approval.
- B. Substantial progress has been made in complying with the conditions of preliminary plat approval.
 - C. It would be inequitable to require the applicant to reapply.
- D. According to K.C.C. 19.28.050 an extension shall not be for more than twelve months from the date a written request is filed, and it may extend a plat up to six years from the date of preliminary plat approval.

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
