ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE dissolving King County Road Improvement District No. 94.

PREAMBLE:

The City of Kent by City Ordinance 3241, effective January 1, 1996, has annexed an area encompassing King County Road Improvement District No. 94.

Road Improvement District No. 94 was created by King County Ordinance 6728 for the purpose of maintaining and providing energy for street lights within the plat of Meadow Hills Division 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby dissolved, King County Road Improvement District No. 94 and the street light maintenance roll established to assess properties within the plat of Meadow Hills Division 2.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 12<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1996.
