AN ORDINANCE dissolving King County Road  
Improvement District No. 117.

PREAMBLE:

The City of Kent by City Ordinance 3241, effective January  
1, 1996, has annexed an area encompassing King County Road  
Improvement District No. 117.

Road Improvement District No. 117 was created by King County  
Ordinance 9491 for the purpose of maintaining and providing  
energy for street lights within the plat of Ahamay Estates.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby dissolved, King County Road  
Improvement District No. 117 and the street light maintenance  
roll established to assess properties within the plat of Ahamay  
Estates.
