AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Hearing Examiner to approve, subject to conditions (modified), the unclassified use permit application submitted by THOMAS J. STEWART, designated DDES File No. L91UU003.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Except as modified by Section 2 below, this ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein as its findings and conclusions the findings and conclusions contained in the report of the hearing examiner dated July 3, 1995, which was filed with the clerk of the council July 20, 1995, as revised and presented to the council for consideration on April 3, 1996, to approve, subject to conditions (modified), the unclassified use permit application submitted by Thomas J. Stewart, and designated land use services division file no. L91UU003, and the council does concur with the recommendation in said report.

SECTION 2. The findings and conclusions adopted above in section one are hereby modified as follows:

A. Condition no. 2 as it appears within the hearing examiner's July 3, 1995, report is deleted and replaced with the following new language:

"No portion of the 100-acre site set out in the legal description for this unclassified use permit application shall be in the future segregated or sold to a separate party. A notice of title approved by King County Department of Development and Environmental Services shall be filed with the King County Department of Records and Elections on all parcels within the 100-acre UUP site."

B. Paragraphs a. and b. of condition no. 6 within the hearing examiner's July 3, 1995, report are amended as follows:

"a. Use of the heliport is restricted to the
following hours:

Monday through Friday: ((7)) 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., with no more than three flight operations between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. in any week.

Weekends and holidays: ((9)) 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Within any calendar month, a maximum of ((two)) six helicopter operations shall be permitted ((during restricted periods)) between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 12:00 a.m. midnight.

b. The total number of heliport operations shall be limited as follows:

Daily: No more than six (6) each day

((Weekly: No more than seventeen (17) each

week))

Monthly: No more than seventy-two (72) each

Yearly: No more than seven hundred thirty
(730) each year"

C. The second sentence of condition no. 8 within the hearing examiner's July 3, 1995, report is deleted and replaced with the following language:

"Beginning five years after the effective date of this approval, and at five year intervals thereafter, the Land Use Services Division Manager shall provide published and mailed notice meeting the requirements of KCC Chapter 21A.40 inviting public comment on permit compliance. If warranted by either an apparent pattern

of noncompliance or conflicting or inadequate information, the Manager may institute a formal hearing process pursuant to the procedures stated within KCC Chapter 21A.42 for periodic permit review."
