ORDINANCE NO. **12313**

AN ORDINANCE authorizing creation of a new
City of Kent 1989 Open Space Bond project
known as the East Hill Expansion project, located
on 248th Street in the City of Kent.

PREAMBLE:

1. The City of Kent (City) has proposed the creation of a new 1989 Open Space Bond project, consisting of the acquisition of 13.11 acres of land located on 248th Street Southeast in the City of Kent, to help provide critical open space in a community with an historic deficit of public park and open space resources.
2. The City has requested that unanticipated surplus funds from the City of Kent Clark Lake 1989 Open Space Bond be used to partially fund the project, to provide needed matching funds for a State of Washington grant that the City will receive for the proposed project.
3. The King County Open Space Citizens Oversight Committee has reviewed the City's proposal and recommends the creation of the proposed City of Kent East Hill Park Expansion 1989 Open Space Bond Project.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted the creation of a new 1989 Open Space Bond Project, known as the City of Kent East Hill Park Expansion Project, a 13.11-acre site located on 248th Street Southeast in the City of Kent.

PASSED by a vote of 12 to 0 this 3rd day of June, 1996.


