ORDINANCE NO. 12389

AN ORDINANCE extending water franchise numbers 318, 617, 5703 and 6289 for Seattle Water Department through October 31, 1996, authorizing the issuance of right of way construction permits in Council Districts 1, 5 and 8.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. Seattle Water Department's franchise numbers 318, 617, 5703 and 6289 to operate and maintain a water system on county roads in council districts 1, 5 and 8 have expired.
- 2. The City of Seattle has requested renewal of said franchises.
- 3. The Seattle Office of Management and Planning has conducted an interdepartmental review of the county's proposed franchise terms and conditions and has raised several issues which need to be negotiated to resolution.
- 4. The extension of the franchises through October 31, 1996 will allow sufficient time for Seattle to conclude negotiations on outstanding issues and obtain both city council and county council approval of the new franchise.
- 5. The extensions of water franchise numbers 318, 617, 5703 and 6289 have been referred to relevant county departments for review.
- 7. No objections have been raised to the granting of the extensions.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter 6.27 to the contrary, the King County executive is hereby authorized to grant an extension of water franchise numbers 318, 617, 5703 and 6289 for Seattle Water Department through October 31, 1996, in substantially the same form as Attachment "A". Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter 14.44 to the contrary, the executive is also authorized to issue right of way construction permits consistent with terms of the extended franchise. Right of way construction permits issued by the property services division and the roads services division between May 5, 1994 and the date of execution of the franchise extension agreements by King County and the City of Seattle shall be considered issued under the terms of the original franchises and the franchise extension agreements.

SECTION 2. If within sixty days after the granting of these extensions, the grantee shall have failed to sign the franchise extension agreements incorporated herein, then the

4	that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or			
5	safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
