ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE extending water system franchise 820 for the Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club until November 10, 1997, and authorizing the issuance of right-of-way construction permits in Council District 3.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- The Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club Franchise 820, to operate and maintain a water system on County road rights-of-way, will expire on May 10, 1996.
- 2. The Club filed an application for a water franchise extension in Council District 3 on April 22, 1996 to construct, operate, and maintain their existing water system to serve a single family residential area.
- 3. King County Code Chapter 6.27 requires that the utility franchise application be approved by the Utilities Technical Review Committee (UTRC) and be consistent with the County's comprehensive plan, Seattle-King County health department and the State department of health regulations.
- The Club is in the process of preparing and obtaining approval of its water comprehensive plan to bring it in compliance with the state and county regulations. The Club anticipates that this process will take a year and a half to complete.
- In order to provide the Club with the time needed to complete its water plan and to allow the Club to continue to operate and maintain the existing water system on county road rights-of-way, the Club has requested that Franchise 820 be extended.
- The extension for Water Franchise 820 has been referred 6. to the relevant County departments for review.
- The County executive has recommended approval of the water franchise extension.

FRANCHISE EXTENSION AGREEMENT

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club currently holds water franchise 820 granted by King County, Washington for the operation of its water system in unincorporated King County; and

WHEREAS, the referenced Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club franchise will expire on May 10, 1996; and

WHEREAS, Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club has requested an extension of said franchise: and

WHEREAS, the Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club, King County and the Utilities Technical Review Committee recommend that said franchise be extended until November 10, 1997 to give the Club the opportunity to complete and obtain approval of its water comprehensive plan and franchise; and

WHEREAS, no objections have been raised to the granting of the request; and

WHEREAS, King County has approved the extension of this franchise until November 10, 1997 through the passage of Ordinance No. /2396 subject to the conditions contained in the ordinance and agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, King County, Washington and the Lake Margaret Community Purposes Club, agree as follows:

- 1. The terms of King County Water Franchise 820 is hereby approved and extended so that it will now expire on November 10, 1997.
- 2. All other conditions of King County Water Franchise 820 shall remain in full force and effect and are not modified or amended by this agreement or Ordinance No. <u>12396</u>.
