2 AN ORDINANCE relating to boating  
3 regulations; prohibiting the use or  
4 operation of internal combustion engines  
5 on Lake Wilderness; and adding a new  
6 section to K.C.C. 12.44.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. There is added to K.C.C. 12.44

9 a new section to read as follows:

10 **Lake Wilderness Restriction.** A. It is unlawful to use  
11 or operate any internal combustion engine on Lake Wilderness,  
12 legally defined as all the water of Lake Wilderness lying  
13 within the East half of Section 21, Township 22 North, Range  
14 6 East, W. M., West half of Section 22, Township 22 North,  
15 Range 6 East, W.M., and the Northwest quarter of Section 27,  
16 Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M., in King County,  
17 Washington; provided that, nothing in this section shall be  
18 construed to prevent any public official or construction  
19 company from performing authorized duties.

The department of public works shall have the responsibility of posting and maintaining appropriate signs.

B. Consistent with K.C.C. 12.44.070, no watercraft equipped with motor propulsion other than internal combustion shall be operated on Lake Wilderness at a speed in excess of eight miles per hour.
