- The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principals and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of transportation, road services division found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as for public use. A search of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of transportation considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
