ORDINANCE NO. **12484**

AN ORDINANCE relating to vehicle parking adjacent to the Kingdome; setting the parking rate and hours of availability in the Kingdome parking lots; amending ordinance No. 7017 Section 1, as amended, Ordinance 11994 and K.C.C. 22.12.030.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 7017, Section 4, as amended, Ordinance 11994 and

K.C.C. 22.12.030 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

Parking. A. Daily Fees

Any person parking a vehicle in the Kingdome parking lot on a daily basis will pay according to the following schedule:

1. Non-Event Day Parking (includes sales tax):

North Parking Lot A

Days, (6:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.) 0 to 3 hours	\$3.00 per parking space
Days, (6:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.) over 3 hours	\$ ((5.00)) <u>6.00</u> per parking space
Evenings, from 5:00 p.m. until 2:00 a.m.	\$3.00 per parking space
Overnight	\$ ((8.00)) <u>9.00</u> per parking space

South Parking Lot or Lot C

Evenings (5:00 p.m. until 2:00 a.m.)	\$2.00 per parking space
Days (6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.)	\$2.00 per parking space

Daily parking is subject to availability, as determined by the director of the department of stadium administration.

2. Event Day Parking North Parking Lot 1, South Parking Lot B, and Lot C Kingdome Lots (includes sales tax):

For Seattle professional football games, thrill shows, and professional basketball exhibition and regular season games.

- 1 Vehicles under 23 feet in length
- 2 Vehicles containing 2 or less passengers \$6.00 per event
- 3 Vehicles containing 3 or more passengers \$5.00 per event
- 4 Vehicles over 23 feet in length, including buses \$12.00 per event.
- 5 All other Stadium Events including professional baseball exhibition and regular
- 6 season games:
- 7 Vehicles under 23 feet in length containing 2 or less occupants \$5.00 per parking space;
- 8 Vehicles under 23 feet in length containing 3 or more occupants \$4.00 per parking space;
- 9 Vehicles over 23 feet in length (including bus(es)es \$12.00 per event.

10 3. Event Day Parking in the covered Pavilion adjacent to the Kingdome
 11 (includes sales tax):

 13 Vehicles under 23 feet in length \$10.00 per event

14 B. Monthly Parking Fees

15 Any person or organization choosing to park a vehicle in the Kingdome parking lots
 16 on a monthly basis will pay according to the following schedule:

17 1. Individual Rate

18 North Parking Lot A ~~\$(65.00))~~ 70.00 per parking space
 19 (plus sales tax)

 21 South Parking Lot B or Lot C \$35.00 per parking space (plus sales tax)

23 The individual rate allows parking from 5:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. on non-event days; parking
 24 is also permitted on event days based on times established by the director of the department
 25 of stadium administration.

26 2. Carpool Parking

27 North Parking Lot A ~~\$(30.00))~~ 33.00 per month for 3 or more
 28 occupants (plus sales tax)

36 3. Group Rate (15 or more permits purchased with one check) in lot C only:

37 For each single occupant vehicle \$25.00 per month (plus sales tax)
 38 For each certified carpool of 2 or more occupants \$15.00 per month (plus sales tax)

39 The carpooling and group rates allow parking from 5:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m. on non-
 40 event days. Parking is also permitted on event days based on times established by the
 41 director of the department of stadium administration.

The daily and monthly parking fees established in this section will not apply to any person or organization whose parking fees are established under a separate negotiated contract between the department of stadium administration and said person or organization.

PROVIDED FURTHER THAT:

The director of the department of stadium administration may establish different event day parking rates based on market rates for events such as, concerts and professional sports playoff games. ~~((The director's authority to establish separate parking rates shall expire on December 31, 1995.))~~

~~C. Effective date. The effective date of this section is January 1, 1996.~~
