AN ORDINANCE relating to elections, calling for special elections to be held to nominate and to elect persons to fill the prescribed elective offices for the newly incorporated city of Covington and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to RCW 35.02.078 and RCW 29.13.010, the county council hereby calls for the records and elections division manager, as supervisor of elections, to hold special elections for the purpose of nominating and electing persons to the elective offices prescribed by law for the city of Covington based on its population and its classification as a non-charter code city with a council-manager form of government
