ORDINANCE NO. 12557

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date of an election on the question of annexation to, adoption of King County Code Title 21A and pro-rata share assumption of indebtedness of the city of Shoreline of an unincorporated area known as Unfinished Business Annexation Area B, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

FINDINGS OF FACT.

- The City of Shoreline, Washington, by Ordinance No. 105 has determined that it is in the public interest, health, safety and general welfare to provide for annexation of an area known as Unfinished Business Annexation Area B, as more fully described in city of Shoreline ordinance No. 105, in accordance with RCW Ch. 35A.14.
- Said ordinance satisfies the provisions of RCW Ch. 35A.14 for qualification for annexation.
- The City of Shoreline, by Ordinance No. 33, initiated the annexation of the area known as Unfinished Business Annexation Area B.
- Pursuant to the provisions of RCW Ch. 36.93, the Boundary Review Board (BRB) approved the

property within the City of Shoreline is assessed and taxed to pay for all or any portion of the outstanding indebtedness of the city of Shoreline.

SECTION 2. The number of registered voters within the subject areas is estimated at 1,120 as nearly as may be determined from available records.

SECTION 3. The King County manager of records and elections is hereby requested to assume jurisdiction of and to call and conduct a special election and submit to the registered voters within the subject area each of the propositions as set forth below. The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and directed to transmit said propositions to the King County manager of records and elections in substantially the following form, with such additions, deletions, deletions or modifications in the ballot titles as may be required for the propositions listed below by the King County prosecutor:

PROPOSITION 1: Shall the area of unincorporated King

ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON: ESTABLISHING A NEW DATE FOR AN ELECTION ON THE QUESTION OF ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF SHORELINE OF AN AREA CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY COMMONLY KNOWN AS UNFINISHED BUSINESS, ANNEXATION AREA B; SUBMITTING THE QUESTION WHETHER, UPON ANNEXATION, KING COUNTY CODE TITLE 21A SHALL \mathbf{BE} ADOPTED AS INTERIM ZONING REGULATIONS; SUBMITTING THE QUESTION OF WHETHER UPON ANNEXATION, ALL PROPERTY ANNEXED SHALL BE TAXED AT THE SAME RATE AND ON THE SAME BASIS AS PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF SHORELINE IS ASSESSED AND TAXED TO PAY FOR ALL OR ANY PORTION OF THE OUTSTANDING INDEBTEDNESS OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 80 AND ORDINANCE NO. 97

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 80, passed on March 25, 1996, called for a special election on the annexation of Unfinished Business, Annexation Area B, on September 17, 1996; and

WHEREAS, on April 10, 1996, the City of Lake Forest Park filed a Petition for Review of the Boundary Review Board's decision approving the City of Shoreline's Notice of Intention to annex Area B; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 97 amended Ordinance No. 80 and rescheduled the special election to November 5, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the litigation initiated by Lake Forest Park required postponement of the November 5, 1996 election until after a decision was rendered by the King County Superior Court; and

WHEREAS, the litigation has been concluded and the election may now be rescheduled;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 3. <u>Ballot Title</u>. The ballot title, as directed by statute, should be substantially as follows:

PROPOSITION A:

- For annexation to the City of Shoreline effective February 15, 1997, and for adoption of King County Code Title 21A, as amended by the City of Shoreline, as zoning regulations for the annexed area.
- Against annexation.

PROPOSITION B:

- For providing that the property annexed shall be taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as property within the City of Shoreline to pay for all or any portion of the outstanding indebtedness of the City of Shoreline.
- Against taxing the annexed property at the same rate and on the same basis as property within the City of Shoreline to pay for all or any portion of the outstanding indebtedness of the City of Shoreline.
- **Section 4.** <u>Description of Area Proposed for Annexation.</u> The boundaries of the area proposed for annexation are described as follows:

THAT PORTION OF THE EAST HALF OF SECTION 16, THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 9; AND THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 15, ALL IN TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 4 EAST, W.M. KENG COUNTY, WASHINGTON;

BEGINNING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE, THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAKE FOREST PARK, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE CITY OF LAKE FOREST PARK ORDINANCE 627, SAID POINT ALSO BEING THE EASTERLY MARGIN OF 25TH AVE NE, AND THE NORTHERLY MARGIN OF 168TH STREET;

THENCE EAST ALONG THE NORTHERLY MARGIN OF 168TH STREET AND FOLLOWING THE LAKE FOREST PARK CITY LIMITS TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE WEST BORDER OF BLOCK 1, MILLERS ADDITION TO LAKE FOREST PARK ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF FOUND IN VOLUME 37 OF PLATS, PAGES 50 AND 51, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON; SAID BORDER ALSO BEING THE EXISTING CITY LIMITS OF LAKE FOREST PARK, AS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE 564,

THENCE SOUTHERLY ALONG THE BORDER OF SAID BLOCK AND FOLLOWING THE LAKE FOREST PARK CITY LIMITS TO THE SOUTH LINE OF SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 26 NORTH, RANGE 4 EAST, W.M.; THENCE EAST ALONG SAID SOUTH LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE WEST LINE OF THE BRIERCREST ADDITION AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 46 OF PLATS, PAGE 69, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, SAID LINE ALSO BEING THE EXISTING CITY LIMITS OF LAKE FOREST PARK, AS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE 569;

THENCE SOUTH ALONG SAID WEST LINE TO THE SOUTH MARGIN OF NE 160TH STREET; THENCE EAST ALONG THE SOUTH MARGIN OF NE 160TH STREET AND FOLLOWING THE LAKE FOREST PARK CITY LIMITS TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE PROLONGATION LINE OF THE WESTERLY LINES OF LOTS 1 THROUGH 7, BLOCKS 4, 9, AND 12 OF STATE PLACE ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF FOUND IN VOLUME 42 OF PLATS, PAGES 10 AND 11, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, SAID LINE ALSO BEING THE EXISTING CITY LIMITS OF LAKE FOREST PARK, AS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE 574;

THENCE SOUTH ALONG SAID WESTERLY LINE TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE NORTHERLY BOUNDARY OF THE PLAT OF CYPRESS SECTION ACACIA MEMORIAL PARK, RECORDED IN VOLUME 93 OF PLATS, PAGES 33 AND 34, RECORDS OF KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ALSO BEING THE SOUTHERLY MARGIN OF NE 155TH STREET; THENCE WESTERLY ALONG THE NORTHERLY BOUNDARY OF SAID PLAT OF CYPRESS SECTION ACTORS

THENCE EASTERLY FOLLOWING THE SOUTHERLY BOUNDARY OF SAID ACACIA MEMORIAL PARK AND THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF SAID ACACIA PARK TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE WESTERLY MARGIN OF BOTHELL WAY NE AND THE CITY LIMITS OF LAKE FOREST PARK:

THENCE SOUTHERLY ALONG THE WESTERLY MARGIN OF BOTHELL WAY NE AND THE CITY LIMITS OF LAKE FOREST PARK, AS ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE 575, TO THE NORTH MARGIN OF NE 145TH STREET NE:

THENCE WESTERLY ALONG THE NORTH MARGIN OF NE 145TH STREET TO THE INTERSECTION WITH THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SHORELINE AND THE WEST MARGIN OF 25TH AVENUE NE: THENCE NORTHERLY ALONG THE CITY LIMITS OF SHORELINE TO THE POINT OF THE BEGINNING.

EXCEPT FOR THAT AREA DESCRIBED AS PROPERTY IN THE NE 1/4 OF SECTION 16 TOWNSHIP 26 N., R 4 W. W.M.:

BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF LOT 8, BLOCK 3 OF STATE PLACE PLAT AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 42, PAGES 10 AND 11 OF PLATS IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON:

THENCE WESTERLY ALONG SAID CITY BOUNDARY TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING;

BEING THE SUBJECT OF CITY OF LAKE FOREST PARK ANNEXATION 49.

- Section 5. <u>Duties of City Clerk/Notice of Election.</u> The City Clerk shall cause notice of the election to be published as required by law. The City Clerk shall promptly provide a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Clerk of the Metropolitan King County Council and to the Manager, King County Records and Elections Division.
 - Section 6. Repealer. Ordinance No. 80 and Ordinance No. 97 are hereby repealed.
- Section 7. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this Ordinance be preempted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or preemption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.
- Section 8 Effective Date and Publication. The City shall publish a summary of this Ordinance consisting of its title in the official newspaper of the City. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after publication.
