AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of a portion of S.W. 242nd Street (aka Robertson Road) V-2191

Petitioner: Wendy A. Cadman

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of S.W. 242nd Street (aka Robertson Road) hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of transportation has notified the utility companies serving the area and was advised that Puget Sound Power and Light Company has secured an easement over the area to be vacated. No other easements are required.
- 3. The land use services division of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of transportation found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A review of the records indicates no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of transportation considers the subject right-of-way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The right-of-way is classified "C-Class" and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due
