ORDINANCE NO. 12590

AN ORDINANCE authorizing expansion of the King County Lower Cedar River Landsburg Reach Waterways 2000 project to include acquisition of the Baccus-Tausend Property.

PREAMBLE:

1. King County has proposed the expansion of the Lower Cedar River Landsburg Reach Waterways 2000 project, consisting of habitat lands along the Cedar River west of Landsburg, to include acquisition of the Baccus-Tausend Property to help provide added salmon habitat and open space protection along the Cedar River.
2. The King County Open Space Citizens Oversight Committee has reviewed King County's proposal and recommends the expansion of the King County Lower Cedar River Landsburg Reach Waterways 2000 project to include acquisition of the 10-acre Baccus-Tausend Property.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted the expansion of the scope of the King County Lower Cedar River Landsburg Reach Waterways 2000 project to include acquisition of the Baccus-Tausend Property.

INTRODUCED AND READ for this first time this 18 day of November, 1996.
