ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the sale of three parcels of fee property located in council district 1 to Seattle Habitat for Humanity.

STATEMENT OF FACTS:

Three properties located on N.E. 175th St. between 5th and 8th Avenues in Shoreline were acquired by King County road services division in conjunction with the N.E. 175th St. road project.

The subject properties became surplus to the custodial department upon completion of the road project.

The subject properties are deemed surplus and no longer necessary for the current or forseeable needs of the county.

King County Ordinance No. 12394, Section 4, allows King County to negotiate a direct sale with a developer of affordable housing provided that the developer has been selected through a request for proposals.

In March 1996, King County's housing and community development program issued an RFP for development of affordable housing on the properties.

Seattle Habitat for Humanity responded to the RFP and was granted funds for the purchase and development of the properties through the Housing Finance Program. Habitat plans to construct three homes on the property.

The sales price of the subject properties is based on the fair market value of \$100,000.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County executive is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents to sell the following described properties to Seattle Habitat for Humanity.
