AN ORDINANCE making supplemental appropriations of \$933,201 to Alcoholism & Substance Abuse, \$9,609,820 to Public Health Pooling Fund, and authorizing a transfer of \$620,000 from the Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Fund to the Housing Opportunity Fund 3220 and amending Ordinance 12029, Sections 79, 85, 110 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted, supplemental appropriations of \$933,201 to the Alcoholism & Substance Abuse, \$8,274,318 to Public Health Pooling as a result of an amendment to the State Department of Health Consolidated Contracts and other grants and contracts.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 12029, Section 79, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting the following:

ALCOHOLISM & SUBSTANCE ABUSE - From the Alcoholism & Substance Abuse Services Fund, there is hereby appropriated to:

Alcoholism & Substance Abuse \$933,201

SECTION 3. Ordinance 12029, Section 85, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting the following:

PUBLIC HEALTH POOLING - From the Public Health Pooling Fund, there is hereby appropriated to:

Public Health Pooling \$8,274,318

SECTION 4. Ordinance 12029, Section 110, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting the following:

From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachment No. 2 of this ordinance.




