A SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE relating to levying the property taxes of King County for the year of 1997 and amending Ordinance 12567, Section 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 12567, Section 2, is amended to read as follows: The Council of King County, Washington, finds that the levies necessary to fund estimated expenditures for the year 1997, less the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus and such expenditures as are to be met from bond warrant issues, be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:



**SUBJECT: An Ordinance relating to levying the property taxes of King County for the year of 1997 and amending Ordinance 12567, Section.**

**SUMMARY:**

Proposed Ordinance 97-35 would certify to the Assessor the amount of property taxes that would be levied by the county, and other taxing districts in the county, in 1997. On December 23, 1996, the council adopted Ordinance 12567. This ordinance also certified to the Assessor the amount of property taxes that would be levied by the county in 1997. However, some levies authorized by Ordinance 12567 were based upon estimates. Proposed Ordinance 97-35 would correct those estimated amounts. A table explaining the corrections are attached to this staff report.
