ORDINANCE NO. 12632

AN ORDINANCE extending water system franchise 1070 for Water District 90 until December 20, 1997, and authorizing the issuance of right-of-way construction permits in Council District 12.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. Water District 90's Franchise 1070, to operate and maintain a water system on County road rights-of-way will expire on December 20, 1996.
- 2. The District will file an application for a water franchise in Council District 12 when their comprehensive plan has been approved to construct, operate and maintain their existing water system to serve residential, multi-family and commercial areas.
- 3. King County Code Chapter 6.27 requires that the utility franchise application be approved by the Utility Technical Review Committee (UTRC) and be consistent with the County's comprehensive plan, Seattle-King County health department and the State department of health regulations.
- 4. The District is in the process of preparing and obtaining approval of its water comprehensive plan to bring it in compliance with the state and county regulations. The District anticipates that this will take approximately one year to complete.
- 5. In order to provide the District with the time needed to complete its water plan and to allow the District to continue to operate and maintain the existing water system on county road rights-of-way, the District has requested that Franchise 1070 be extended.
- 6. The extension for Water Franchise 1070 has been referred to the relevant County departments for review.
- 7. The County executive has recommended approval of the water franchise extension.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter 13.24 to the contrary, the King County executive is hereby authorized to grant an extension of Water Franchise 1070 for Water District 90 until December 20, 1997, in substantially the same form as Attachment "A". Notwithstanding any provision of K.C.C. Chapter 14.44 to the contrary, the executive is also authorized to issue right-of-way permits consistent with the terms of the extended franchise.
