ORDINANCE NO. **12655**

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$500,000 to ITS-Data Processing from fund balance and amending Ordinance 12029, Section 102, as amended, and authorizing the Executive to enter into a five year install-purchase agreement for computer equipment.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted a supplemental appropriation of \$500,000 to ITS-Data Process from available fund balance in the CCS-Data Processing fund for the acquisition and installation of new computer equipment.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 12029, Section 102, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

ITS-DATA PROCESS - From the CCS-Data Processing fund there is hereby appropriated to:

ITS-Data Process \$500,000

PROVIDED THAT within the resources provided, ITS and the vendor shall conduct an inventory of all current mainframe

1 applications, and shall also conduct an application audit, to
2 determine the serviceability of all current mainframe
3 computer applications through the year 2002. The application
4 audit shall identify the current condition of each mainframe
5 application, and shall include recommended refinements or
6 replacement where appropriate. The inventory and audit shall
7 be submitted to the Budget and Fiscal Management Committee on
8 or before May 31, 1997.

9 PROVIDED FURTHER THAT the ITS director shall submit a
10 written report and work plan demonstrating that "Year 2000"
11 mainframe computer issues will be resolved for all mainframe
12 computer applications no later than March 31, 1999. The
13 "Year 2000" report shall be submitted to the Budget and
14 Fiscal Management Committee on or before May 31, 1997.

PASSED by a vote of 11 to 0 this 16th day of March, 1997.


