AN ORDINANCE authorizing the vacation of the Alley in Block 2, First Addition to Preston - V-2280 Petitioner: Karl Weiser

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of the Alley in Block 2, First Addition to Preston, as recorded in volume 12 of plats, page 32. records of King County, Washington, hereinafter described.
- 2. The current alignment of 308th Avenue Southeast lies outside of the dedicated right-of-way. The existing 308th Avenue Southeast encroaches onto the petitioners property., The petitioner is proposing that King County exchange the vacated alley for the portion of his property being utilized by 308th Avenue Southeast in lieu of compensation for the vacation area.
- 3. The department of transportation has notified the various utility companies serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required.
- 4. The land use section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not conflict with the principals and purposes of the King County comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 5. The department of transportation found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open for public use. A review of the records indicate that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of transportation considers the subject alley right-of-way useless

as part of the county road system and believes that the public would benefit by the return of this unused alley right-of-way to the public tax rolls.

- 6. The proposed vacation area is classified "C-Class" and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent of the assessed value of the adjoining lands which may be determined from records of the department of assessments. The value of the alley right-of-way is \$4,270.68.
- 7. The assessed value of the exchange right-of-way on 308th Avenue South is \$8,912.31. The department of transportation recommends waiving the compensation fee for vacating the subject alley in exchange for the deed to 308th Avenue Southeast across the petitioners property. The department of transportation is in receipt of the deed for that portion of exchange right-of-way. The deed will be recorded upon the vacation of the alley right-of-way.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the office of the hearing examiner on the day of February, 1996.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
