STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of that portion of Lake Dorothy Highway hereinafter described.
- 2. The department of transportation, road services division has notified the various utility companies serving the area and has been advised that easements are not required in the vacation area.
- 3. The land use services section of the department of development and environmental services has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed road right-of-way vacation.
- 4. The department of transportation, road services division found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A review of the records indicate that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The department of transportation considers the subject right-of-way unnecessary as part of the county road system and believes the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
- 5. The right-of-way is classified "C-Class" and in accordance with King County Code 14.40.020, the compensation due King County is based on fifty percent of the assessed value of the adjoining lands which is determined from records of the department of assessments. King County is in receipt of the required compensation in the amount of \$245.67 paid by the petitioner.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the office of the hearing examiner on the 23d day of 340, 197.
