ORDINANCE NO. 12801

AN ORDINANCE approving the city of Redmond Bear Creek Basin  
Sewer System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

K.C.C. 13.24 requires approval of comprehensive plans and plan updates for sewer purveyors as a prerequisite to the granting of right-of-way franchises and approval of right-of-way construction permits;

The King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to consider the plan on November 8, 1995, and finding it consistent with K.C.C. 13.24, recommended approval;

The city of Redmond issued a Determination of Nonsignificance for the plan in accordance with the State Environmental Policy Act on October 24, 1995;

The city of Redmond adopted the plan via ordinance 1929 on March 18, 1997.
