ORDINANCE NO. 12812

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation of the city of Covington into the King County Rural Library District and declaring an emergency.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The city of Covington, Washington by Ordinance No. 15-97 has initiated the proposed annexation and expressed its intent to join the King County Rural Library District, finding that the public interest will be served thereby. Because there is no city-appointed library board, the state librarian has been notified per RCW 27.12.360.

City of Covington Ordinance No. 15-97 satisfies the provisions of RCW 27.12.010 (5), and 27.12.360 and requests the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein.

The Board of Trustees of the King County Rural Library District by Resolution No. 1997-5 has concurred with the proposal in accordance with RCW 27.12.360.

ORDINANCE NO. 15-97

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF COVINGTON, KING WASHINGTON, DECLARING THE CITY'S COUNTY, INTENT TO JOIN AND BE ANNEXED TO THE KING COUNTY RURAL LIBRARY DISTRICT; REQUESTING THE CONCURRENCE OF THE LIBRARY DISTRICT BOARD OF REQUESTING TRUSTEES; AND THE KING COUNCIL TO CALL AN ELECTION IN THE CITY ON THE PROPOSITION OF WHETHER THE CITY SHOULD ANNEXED TO THE LIBRARY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the City of Covington will incorporate on August 31, 1997; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 27.12.360, the City will have the option of providing library services to its residents by annexing to the King County Rural Library District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 27.12.360, the process of annexation is initiated by an ordinance of the City Council declaring the City's intent to join the Library District and finding that the public interest will be served thereby; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the public interest will be served by annexing the City to the King County Rural Library District and, in addition, that such annexation is in the best interest of the citizens of Covington,

Now, therefore, the City Council of the City of Covington, King County, Washington do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Declaration of Intent and Finding. The City of Covington hereby declares its intent to join and be annexed to the King County Rural Library District. Having reviewed the options for providing library service to the residents of the City, the City Council finds that the public interest will best be served by the annexation of the City to the Library District.

Section 2. Request for Concurrence of Library District.

Pursuant to RCW 27.12.360, the City Council requests that the Board of Trustees of the King County Rural Library District concur in the proposed annexation of the City to the Library District.

Section 3. Request for Special Election. Pursuant to RCW 27.12.360 and RCW 27.12.370, if the Board of Trustees of the King County Rural Library District concur in the annexation, the King County Council is requested to call by resolution a special election to be held in the City of Covington on the date of the September, 1997, primary election for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the City the proposition of whether the City should annex to the King County Rural Library District. The King County Council is also requested to give notice of the election as provided for in RCW 29.27.080. The proposition to be submitted at said election shall be in the form of a ballot title as follows:
