AN ORDINANCE relating to telecommunications, granting a county-wide wireless digital communications radio network franchise to Metricom, Inc., and authorizing the King County executive to sign a franchise agreement and other documents relating to the granting of the franchise.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Findings of Fact:

A. Metricom, Inc. has applied to King County (county) for a franchise to build, operate, repair, and maintain a wireless digital communications radio network on county road rights-of-way within the unincorporated portions of the county.

B. The county commenced a proceeding which afforded the public and Metricom, Inc. appropriate notice and participation for the purpose of (i) identifying the county's future communications related needs and interests, (ii) reviewing Metricom, Inc.'s ability to comply with the provisions of the proposed franchise, and (iii) determining whether the granting of the franchise is in the best interests of the people of King County.

C. The county has concluded that it is appropriate and in the best interests of the people of King County to grant Metricom, Inc. a franchise to use the road rights-of-way of King County for the construction, operation, repair and maintenance of a wireless digital communications radio network to provide data, internet, and internet-related services in the county subject to the terms and conditions contained in this ordinance, applicable law, the proposed franchise, which is attached as Attachment A, and appendices to the proposed
