ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE concurring with the recommendation of the Hearing Examiner to approve the application of SOUTHLAND CORPORATION to amend King County Zoning Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by reclassifying certain property designated Land Use Services File No. L97RZ001.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance adopts and incorporates the findings and conclusions of the July 24, 1997, report and recommendation of the hearing examiner filed with the clerk of the council on August 14, 1997, to approve a zone reclassification of certain property presently zoned R-48-P (Urban Residential, 48 units per acre, with P-suffix conditions) to CB-P (Community Business with P-suffix conditions) on the application of Southland Corporation, as described in land use services file no. L97RZ001.

SECTION 2. The recommendation of the hearing examiner to reclassify the subject property is hereby adopted. Those conditions which must be satisfied before this ordinance becomes effective must be satisfied within two years of council approval, or all authority granted by this ordinance shall expire and this ordinance shall be of no further force or effect.

Upon this ordinance becoming effective, the land use services division shall amend the official zoning maps of King County to reflect this action.
