Except as modified by Section 2 below, this ordinance does hereby adopt and incorporate herein as its findings and conclusions the findings and conclusions contained in the report and recommendation of the hearing examiner dated July 9, 1997, which was filed with the clerk of the council July 10, 1997, to deny in part, and grant in part, appeals from a King County Landmarks and Heritage Commission decision to designate the Issaquah Sportsmen's Clubhouse a King County landmark, designated Landmarks and Heritage Commission File No. LMC97001, and the council does hereby adopt as its action the recommendation(s) contained in said report.

SECTION 2. The findings and conclusions adopted above in section one are hereby

modified to include the following new condition which shall apply to the Issaquah Sportsmen's Clubhouse as a designated landmark:

CONDITIONS

1. If the Clubhouse is proposed to be moved in the future, such move shall be limited to a similar wooded or park location.
