ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE proposing to amend the King County Charter regarding contracts and procurement processes; authorizing the increased use of county employees on county road projects; authorizing the use of procurement processes established by ordinance or general law; amending section 815 of Article 8 of the Charter; and submitting the same to the voters of the county for their ratification or rejection at the November 1997 general election.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the qualified voters of King County for their approval and ratification or rejection, at the next general election to be held in this county occurring more than 45 days after the enactment of this ordinance, an amendment to section 815 of Article 8 in the King County Charter as set forth herein.

## SECTION 2. Section 815. Contracts and ((Competitive Bidding)) Procurement Processes.

The construction of all public buildings and works shall be performed by independent contractors ((;except that)) except as provided otherwise in this charter or by general law. ((County road projects having a value of less than twenty-five thousand dollars may be performed by county employees.)) County employees may perform county road projects up to the separate project cost limits authorized by general law for the performance of public buildings and works by county

employees. ((Whenever the county would have been required to do so by general law if it had not adopted this charter, it)) The county shall purchase all property and award all contracts by ((competitive bidding in accordance with the procedures)) procurement processes established by ordinance or general law. ((Provided that, when permitted by law, there shall be established a small works roster composed of all contractors who have requested to be placed on it and who are properly licensed to perform such work in this state. The county may award contracts using this roster for all contracts of one hundred thousand dollars or less, in accordance with procedures to be established by ordinance.))

SECTION 3. The manager of the division of records and elections shall cause notice of the proposed amendment to Article 8 of the King County Charter to be published in accordance with the State Constitution and general law and placed on the ballot at the November 4, 1997 election, which is the next general election occurring more than 45 days after enactment of this ordinance.
